

Minutes – December 18, 2023

PTA president Christina Yazbek called the meeting to order at 7:04 PM. Quorum met with 11 members logged on at 7:23 PM. Tonilyn Riccardi- 1st V.P., Diana Armandi-Treasurer and Mrs. Kimball-Principal, were in attendance. Christina Minetto- 2nd V.P. and Johana Tedesco- Secretary were absent.

Secretary's Report (given by Christina Yazbek)

- 11 members logged on. Quorum met.

- Mrs. Kimball emailed the November minutes, budget, and agenda to the membership. No discussion took place; proceeded with vote. 8 ayes, 0 nays. The minutes were approved.

Treasurer's Report (Diana Armandi)

Current balance in bank account is \$19, 925.29.

Fundraisers:

- White Post sale: brought in \$2,061, paid them their cut=\$1,527.50, profit=\$533.50
- Comedy night: brought in \$589, paid out \$250.01, profit= \$338.99
- Greeting cards (cards for a cause): collected \$660, paid them \$374, profit= \$286
- Gift card sale (Raiseright): collected \$5,451.45, paid them their share \$5,167.88, profit \$283.57

Revenue:

McDonald's profit check received \$500.00.

Expenses:

- Spent \$44.53 on copy paper.
- We spent \$993.20 on winter wishes for the classroom presents.
- Spent \$449.03 on staff appreciation (Olive Garden donated for 50 people & the PTA supplied the additional). We also purchased a giveaway for staff appreciation this year.
- Cultural arts- paid for circus \$1,033.65 (we had a credit of \$6,191.10 & circus has fulfilled that credit).
- Membership is ongoing. This is not the final # but we currently collected for 187 members; \$1,870, paid \$756 in dues and have a profit of \$1,114.
- Holiday fair numbers not in yet.

Report of Standing Committees

- **Membership**: Currently we have 187 members. Our goal is 216 members for the year. Membership is ongoing, not too late to join.
- **Cultural Arts:** Still working on booking programs for all the grades. Circus has completed their program. The fifth graders performed for the whole school during the day and for their families for an evening performance.

- Our Greeting Card Sale ended Nov 13th. We sold just over 20 boxes. All orders were distributed.

- Star Lab (mobile planetarium) visited. Students got to experience the new, bigger planetarium and participate in age appropriate astrology presentations.
- We have a new digital PA system. The announcements are louder and clearer. Classrooms can control the volume. The display shows text and flashes lights. Music can also be piped in through the system.

- On Thursday, December 21st, grades K-2 will search Bosti for the Gingerbread Man. Grades 3-5 will go on a technology based scavenger hunt.
